## Unacceptable Items

Small Kitchen Appliances	Battery powered consumer products such as power tools, toys, toothbrushes, Cordless power tools
Vacuum Cleaners, Shop Vacs	Non-electronic items such as CD's, VHS Tapes, DVD's, memory sticks & floppy discs
Lamps & Light Bulbs	Hazardous Waste (pesticides, aerosols, cleaners)
Batteries (other than those in electronic devices)	Medical equipment (can be accepted on a case by case basis)
Gas powered lawn equipment	Mercury Containing (thermostats, switches)
Gas Cylinders (propane, etc)	Ballasts/Capacitors
Contaminated electronic waste such as medical equipment	All Wood, including wood-encased stereo speakers
Solar Panels	Radioactive Devices (including smoke detectors & Exit Lights)
Fans	Appliances such as refrigerators, washers, dryers, stoves, ovens, water heaters, air conditioners
Vehicle Air Bags	Miscellaneous Household Goods such as swiffers, clocks, waffle irons, irons, sanders, staplers, Lamps
